

# *The healing of the man born blind*

**John 9:1-17**

As he walked along, (Jesus) saw a man blind from birth. His disciples asked him, '*Rabbi, who sinned, this man or his parents, that he was born blind?*' Jesus answered, '*Neither this man nor his parents sinned; he was born blind so that God's works might be revealed in him. We must work the works of him who sent me while it is day; night is coming when no one can work. As long as I am in the world, I am the light of the world.*'

When he had said this, he spat on the ground and made mud with the saliva and spread the mud on the man's eyes, saying to him, '*Go, wash in the pool of Siloam*' (which means Sent).

Then (the blind man) went and washed and came back able to see.

The neighbours and those who had seen him before as a beggar began to ask, '*Is this not the man who used to sit and beg?*' Some were saying, '*It is he.*' Others were saying, '*No, but it is someone like him.*' He kept saying, '*I am the man.*' But they kept asking him, '*Then how were your eyes opened?*'

He answered, '*The man called Jesus made mud, spread it on my eyes, and said to me, "Go to Siloam and wash."* Then I went and washed and received my sight.'

They said to him, '*Where is he?*'

He said, '*I do not know.*'

They brought to the Pharisees the man who had formerly been blind. Now it was a sabbath day when Jesus made the mud and opened his eyes. Then the Pharisees also began to ask him how he had received his sight. He said to them, '*He put mud on my eyes. Then I washed, and now I see.*' Some of the Pharisees said, '*This man is not from God, for he does not observe the sabbath.*' But others said, '*How can a man who is a sinner perform such signs?*' And they were divided. So they said again to the blind man, '*What do you say about him? It was your eyes he opened.*' He said, '*He is a prophet.*'
